Biography

Graduated from National University of Ireland in Dublin with Honours Degree & Gold Medal in 1982. He obtained his MRCP (UK) in 1985. Dr Chan received his cardiology training at Aberdeen Royal Infirmary, Scotland, Green Lane hospital, New Zealand and University Hospital Charles Nicolle, Rouen, France. He was admitted as a Fellow of Royal College of Physicians (Edinburgh) in 1996 and American College of Cardiology in 1999.

Dr Chan was lecturer in Medicine at the University of Aberdeen from 1984 to 1986 and was appointed as Clinical Associate Professor of Medicine at the National University of Singapore in 2001. He was formerly a Senior Consultant Cardiologist and Director of the Interventional Cardiology at the National Heart Centre, Singapore.

Dr Chan is widely known in the region and is considered a foremost expert in the fields of coronary interventions, peripheral interventions including carotid stenting and aortic and mitral balloon valvuloplasty. He is a faculty member of TCT (USA), Summit MD (Seoul), Euro PCR Annual Scientific Meetings. He has published over 100 peer reviewed manuscripts in international journals and has contributed several book chapters.
