Biography

Dr Gerald Tan is an MOH-certified consultant urologist with over 17 years of clinical experience. He completed a 2-year fellowship in da Vinci robotic surgery for prostate cancer at Weill Medical College, Cornell University, New York. He is widely recognized for his expertise in minimally invasive robotic surgery for prostate, kidney and bladder diseases.

Dr Tan has been involved in over 450 robotic radical prostatectomies, and pioneered robotic partial nephrectomy for kidney cancer and robotic radical cystectomy for muscle-invasive bladder cancer in Tan Tock Seng Hospital, Singapore. He has served as Course Director for numerous symposia and masterclasses in robotic and minimally invasive urologic surgery, and shares his expertise extensively as invited speaker and faculty in workshops and conferences in the United States, United Kingdom, Hong Kong, Shanghai, Japan, Malaysia, Cambodia and Thailand.

Dr Tan has received numerous top international awards for research and clinical excellence. In 2009, he received the Outstanding Young Persons of Singapore Award (Medical Innovation) by Junior Chamber International (Singapore). In 2012, he was named the Outstanding Young Urologist of Asia by the Urological Association of Asia.
